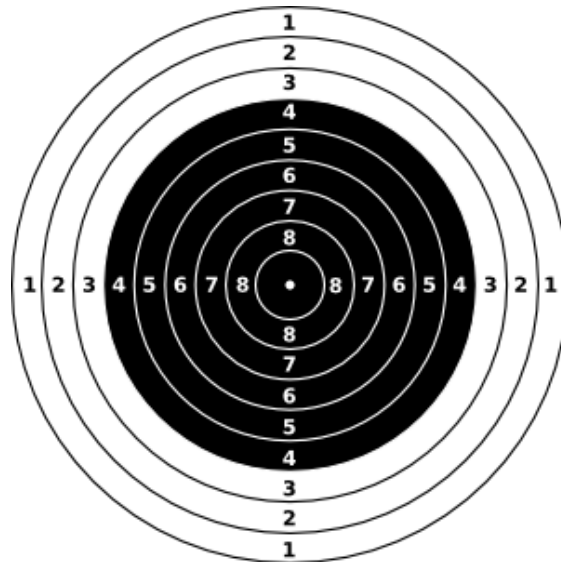

The objective of Camelot Target Shooting Club is to act as an interface between youth organisations, junior shooters (under 21), and the target shooting community to facilitate an accessible quality target shooting activity for young people.

As shooters reach 21 years of age they are then invited to receive continuing support provided they also provide support to juniors themselves.

The objective of CTSC may be achieved by ~

- Recruitment of adults with appropriate skills into Camelot TSC, such adults to hold CRB clearance from their youth organisation or to apply for it via NSRA.
- Promotion of NSRA training to adults engaged in instructing junior shooters.
- Provision of an advisory service, within NSRA guidelines and best practice.
- Support by the provision of equipment.
- Fund raising to both support activity and for the provision of equipment.
- Organisation of competitions / teams "as and when" appropriate.
